



General terms of participation and entries

The organization of motoUP hereby states that the safety of the competitors and all other people present at the track event is of highest priority!

1. General terms on participation

All participants must be in good, physical and mental health. If there is any doubt about the condition of the participant, he/she, on demand of the organization, must see the track doctor for a medical scrutiny. After any crash, an examination by the track doctor is compulsory.

Participants who (still) are under the influence of alcohol, drugs or heavy medicine will be denied access to the track. There will be no refund of the entry fee!

Creating a "burnout" or intentional "wheelies" is forbidden, both on the track and also in the paddock!

All participants must be dressed in an undamaged leather racing suit or zippered leather combination, an undamaged approved helmet, boots with protectors, gloves with protection, and a back protector.

In keeping with civil and penal law, the participant has sole responsibility for any damage that they cause or their vehicle causes, unless otherwise indicated in these general terms and conditions.

He / she participates in the training at his/her own risk.

All participants are aware that they are riding on a closed circuit and that rules and laws that apply to driving on public roads, are not applicable.

All participants must be in possession of health insurance, also valid for other countries.

All participants must adhere to the instructions of the track and staff, directions, groups and timing of the organization and its employees.

This disclaimer does not apply to damages arising from injury to life, limb or health resulting from a deliberate or grossly negligent breach of obligation, including breaches by legal representatives/the organiser's agents who are otherwise absolved of obligation. Nor does it apply to any other damages resulting from a deliberate or grossly negligent breach of obligation, including breaches by legal representatives or the organiser's agents who are otherwise absolved of obligation.

The rider waives any claims against other participants – riders, passengers, the organiser's agents, owners or keepers of other vehicles – of any nature resulting from training sessions or competitions. This does not apply to damages arising from injury to life, limb or health resulting from a deliberate or grossly negligent breach of obligation, including breaches by legal representatives/the organiser's agents who are otherwise absolved of obligation. Nor does it apply to any other damages resulting from a deliberate or grossly negligent breach of obligation, including breaches by legal representatives or the organiser's agents who are otherwise absolved of obligation.

The rider is responsible for organising sufficient insurance cover (vehicle, private liability, health insurance).

All participants and their supervisors, maintenance services, organization and staff must respect the general rules of conduct. The organization reserves the right to exclude any person from the training or stay on the paddock, who violates the general rules of conduct. There will be no refund of the entry fee.

The participant is obliged to attend the riders' briefings. Failure to attend may result in the participant being barred from the event by the organiser, without the right to a refund or a reduction in the fee.

During events, the rider must not endanger other participants through his or her actions. Bikes must be ridden at a walking pace throughout the entire paddock and box area. It is strictly forbidden to stop on the track, for whatever reason. Training sessions often involve riders of different speed and abilities, so all riders must be attentive at all times and show consideration for others.

2. Entries

Participants must register by the official entry form, postal or email message or confirmation.

In case of the entrant being younger than 18 years of age, the entry must also be confirmed and signed by an adult parent or tutor.

Entryforms may not be manipulated or changed by participants.

All participants and/or their parent/tutor must sign the liability disclaimer before entering the track. Incomplete forms are not considered.

The rider is responsible to the event organizer for ensuring that he or she is the only person permitted to drive the vehicle he or she has registered for the event. The entry is personal and cannot be transferred to another person or participant, without the consent of the organizer.

Observation of this fact leads to the complete exclusion of all other training and events of motoUP.com!

By registering for an event, the rider waives the right to make any claims for damages resulting from an event, be this against the organizer, race stewards, medical staff, the race track owner, sponsors, racing services or other parties involved in the organization of the event, including the organizer's agents and persons contracted by the organizer within its obligations.

Entries are definitive and confirmed after payment of the entryfee. There is no legal claim to reservation until the entry fee is paid or transferred by bank account. Entries are considered in order of payment, not on date of entry.

Entries without payment are reserved for 21 days, after this date the right on reservation is expired.

Acceptation of entries is sole by the organizer; the organizer reserves the right to refuse an entry/participant without reason. In such a case, paid entry fees will be returned asap.

3. Starting numbers

Participants may apply for a / their specific starting number. The organization will consider as possible the allocation of these numbers. Applications are in order of paid entries.

All participants will have their unique starting number for the event. In case a participant having more motorcycles, all bikes must have the same number.

Minimum size of the numbers is heigth 12 cms and width 2 cms.

Numbers must be clear visible on front and side panels of the motorcycle.

Numbers are available at the technical service.

4. Cancellation/reversal of entry by the participant

entries without cancellation fee:

- a. up to 60 days before the event: -entry fee 100% refund
- b. up to 30 days before the event: -entry fee minus 50 euros refund
- c. up to15 days before the event: -voucher of 60% of the entry fee for running year

entries with cancellation fee:

- d. up to 30 days before the event -entry fee 100% refund
- e. up to 15 days before the event -entry fee minus 35 euros refund
- f. up to10 days before the event: -voucher of 100% of the entry fee for 1 calendar year
- g. up to15 days before the event: -voucher of 80% of the entry fee for 1 calendar year
- h. up to the start of the event -voucher of 60% of the entry fee for 1 calendar year

All cancellations must be in writing stating all details.

In case of a breakdown, crash, engine failure, exclusion of the participant, bad weather or any other reason, within 72 hours before, during or after the event in question there will be no refund of the full or partial entry fee.

In case of cancellation, a participant may arrange a substitutional entry, provided that the entry is for the same number of days and the same classification or group. The entry fee must be deducted with each other by both participants. There will be no refund by the organizer.

If the entrant is not present at the registration of the event or does not show up at all and has not made a written cancellation before or at the event, the complete entry fee is lapsed. There will be no refund by the organizer.

In these cases, all cancellations must be in writing, stating all details. Email and SMS-messages are valid.

5. Cancellation/reversal of entry by the organization

If an event due to force majeure, can not take place within 40 working days, but until 72 hours before the event, the organization will offer a substitutional date and / or circuit within the current calendar year.

Registered participants can transfer their entry to the replacement event / circuit or a circuit / event within the current calendar. If a registered participant does not wish to use the replacement event, the hitherto paid registration fee is to be refunded within 30 days after the last day of the event reversed, at the rates listed below 4.b and 4.d

In case of cancellation of an event by the organization, registered participants are not entitled to reimbursement for costs already incurred, such as hotel bookings, flights, rental cars, holidays included, etc.

If, due to bad weather, the track owner and / or the organization decide(s) because of the inherent dangers and risks, to cancel the event within 72 hrs. to or during the event, there will be no refund of the complete or partial entry fee. The organizer will offer the participants a substitutional event / track during a period of 2 calendar years.

Entries are not transmissible in this case. All cancellation terms under 4. expire in this case.

6. Confirmation of entries

Participants will receive a confirmation of their entry by email within 48 hours after payment of the entry fee.

Rejected entries will receive message within 24 hours.
